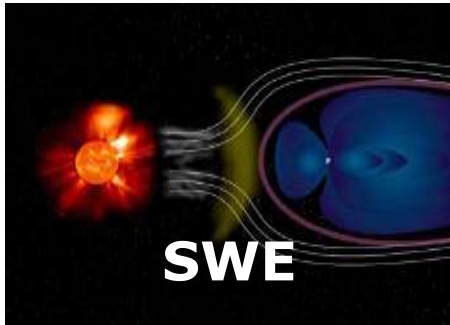

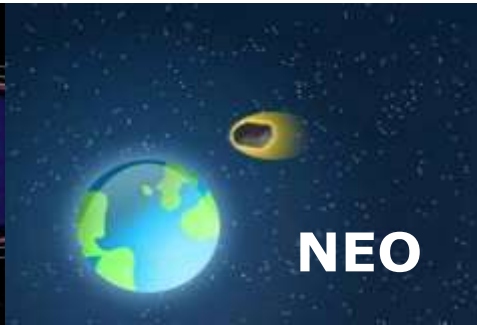
Space Situational Awareness - Goals

Near Earth Objects



Period 3 (2017 – 2020)



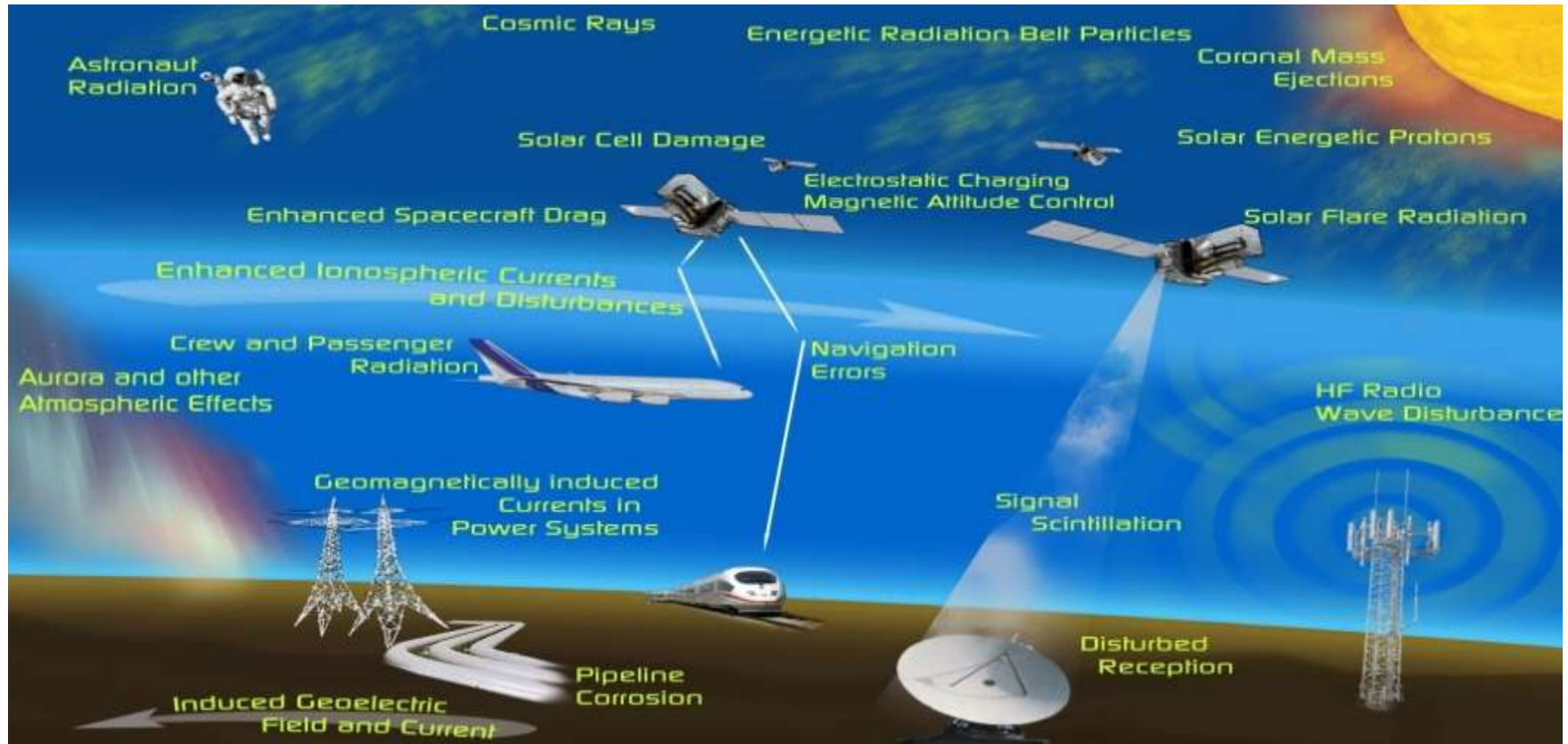

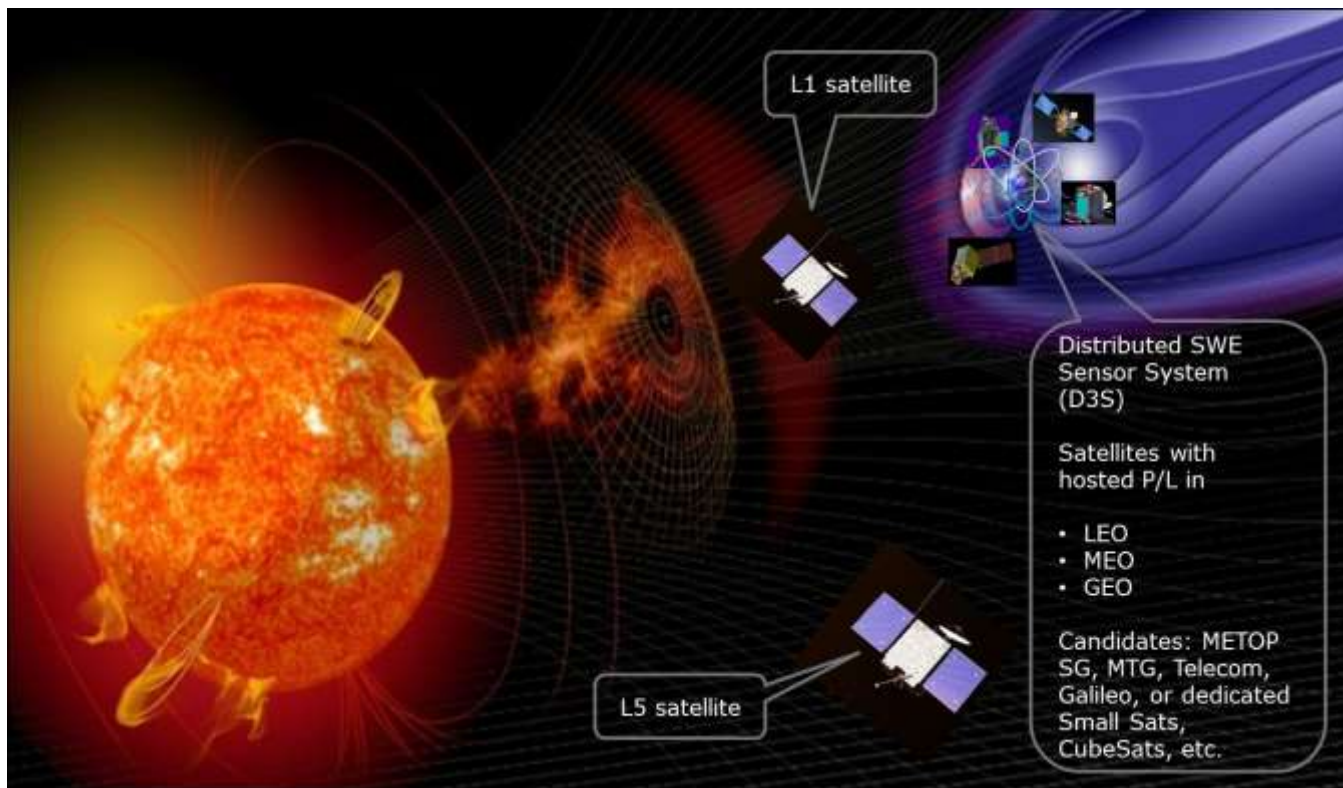

- EUV imaging

 - magnetic field
 - charged particles
 - hot plasma
